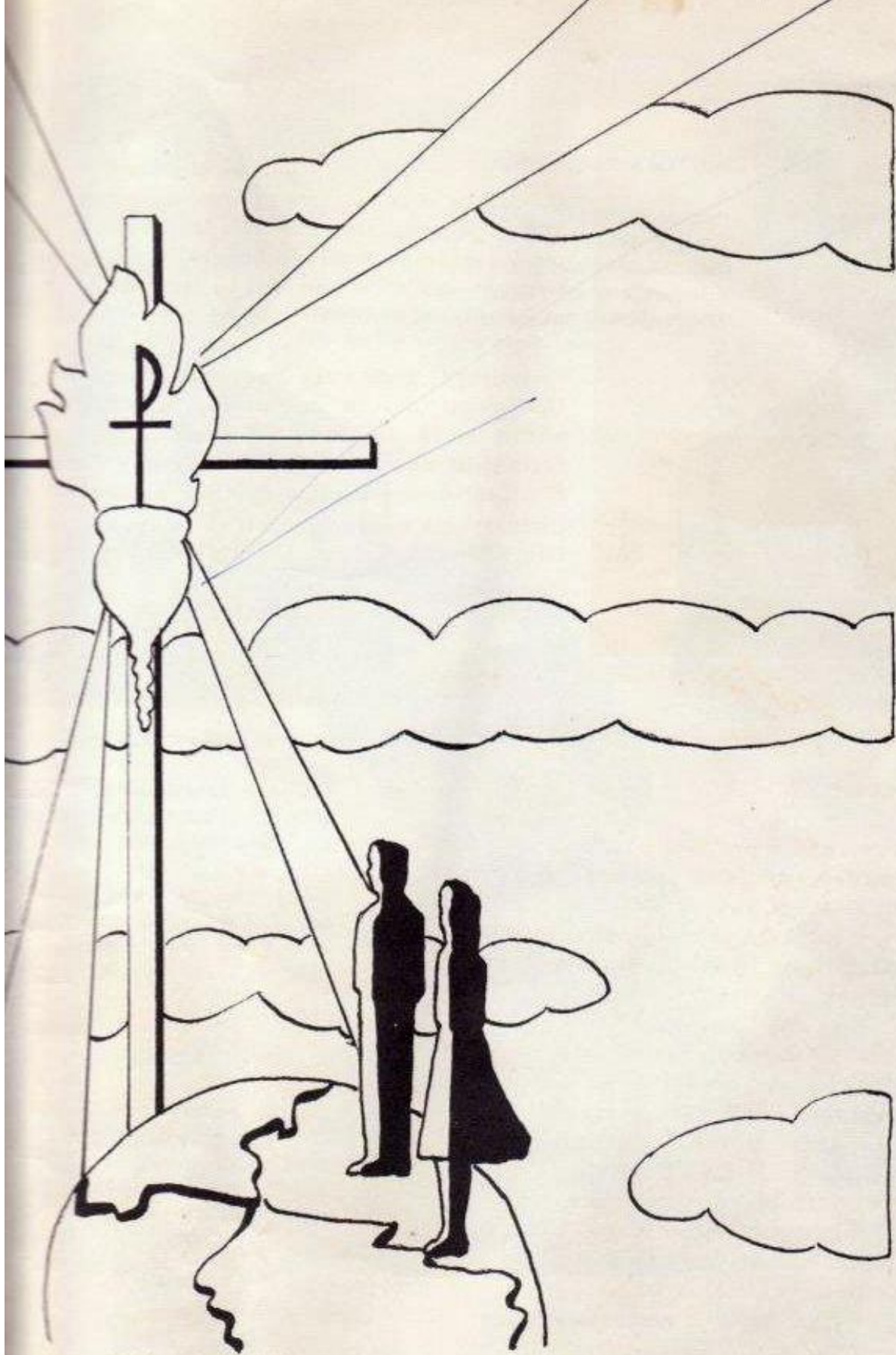
You can no longer stand alone without upholding others if you prove true to your training, nor can you fall without dragging countless others down with you, should you fail to live the principles and ideals taught you.

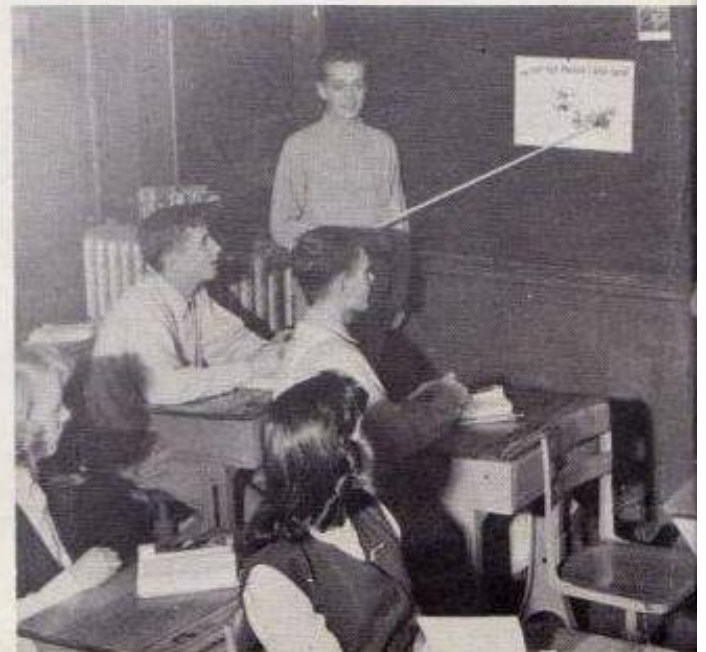

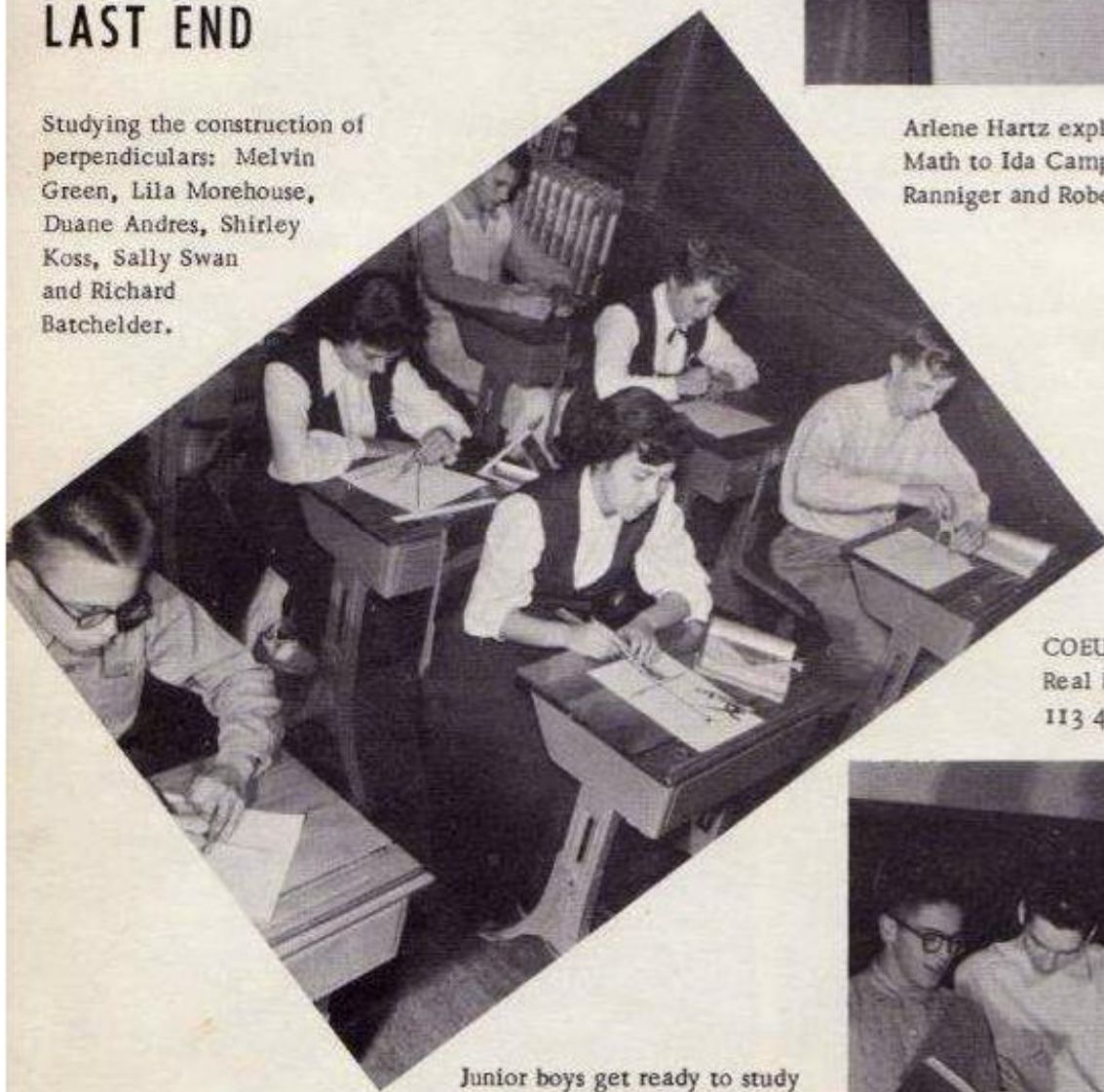

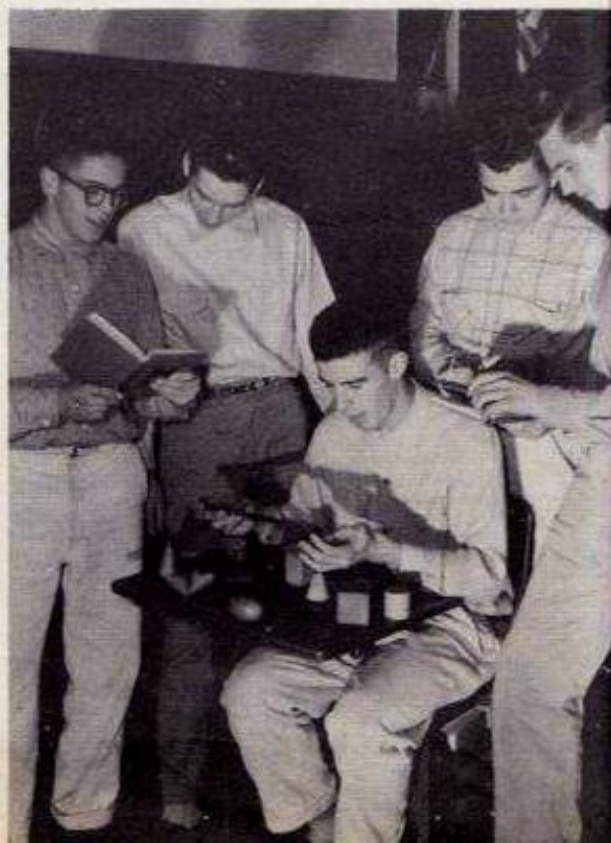

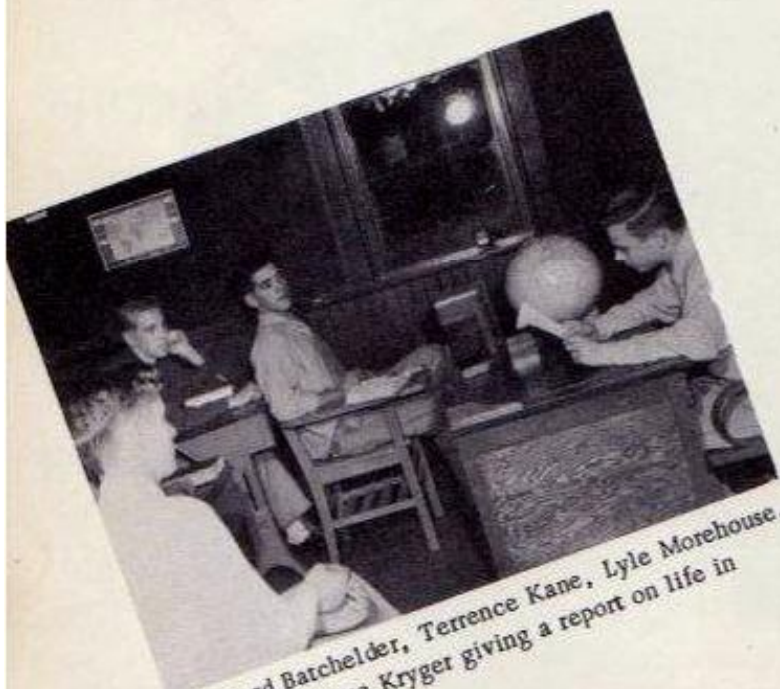

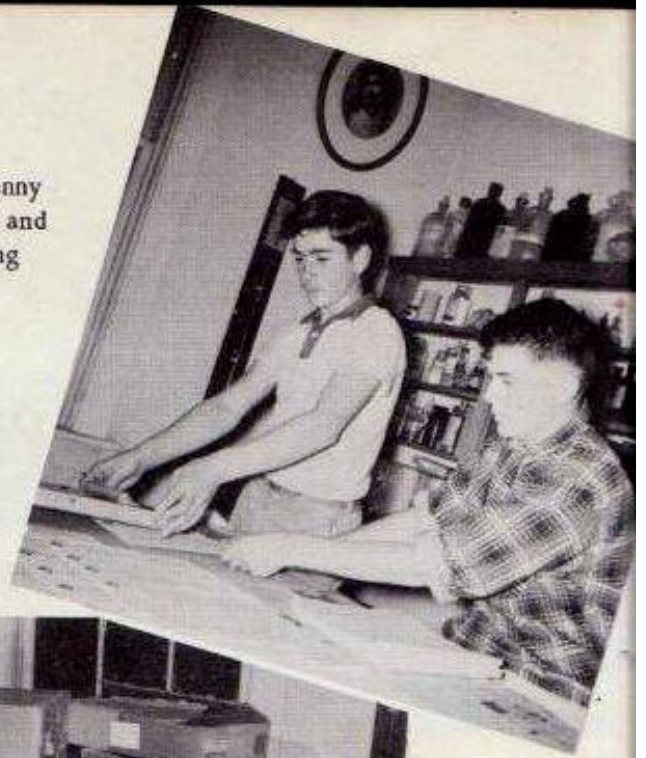

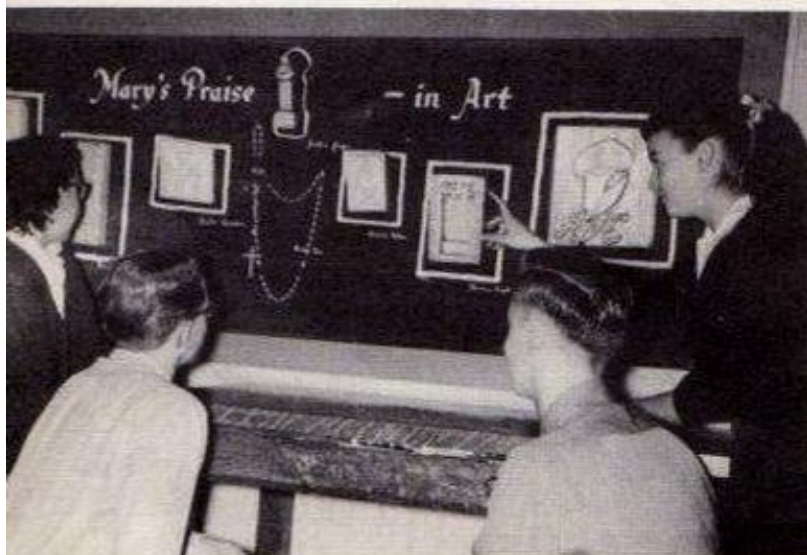

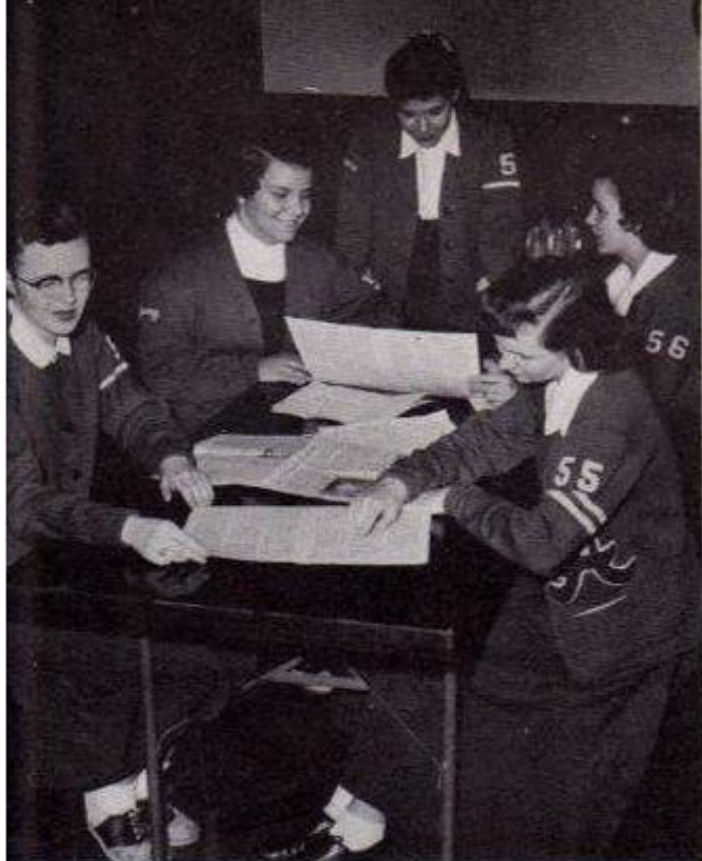

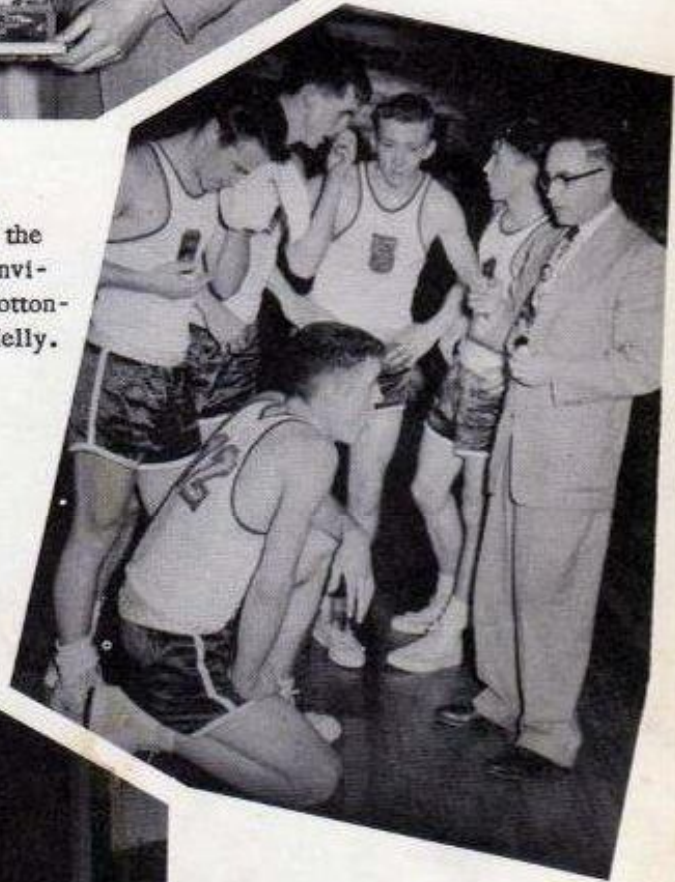
