Mrs. HOTTELL did volunteer work at St. Augustine Elementary School, Sacred Heart Hospital, Meals on Wheels, the information booth at Riverfront Park, the Service Corps of Retired Executives (SCORE) and at the Small Business Administration. She moved to Kirkland three years ago. She was a member of St. Aloysius Catholic Church.

Her husband and a daughter preceded her in death. Survivors include three sons, Gary HOTTELL of Spokane, Richard HOTTELL, Springfield VA, and Dennis HOTTELL, Fairfax Station VA; two daughters, Patricia REDMOND, Spokane and Mary DeVAULT, Seattle.
