
David Darcy <u>'68</u> DIEMERT, 1950 ~ 2011

With his family by his side, David Darcy DIEMERT, a loved father, son, brother, uncle and loyal friend, went to be with the angels in heaven on April 7, 2011. He was born March 21, 1950, in Wahpeton ND to Leonard and Rose () DIEMERT.

David attended Captain Gray School, Pasco, Wash., -Kindergarten; St. Patrick's Grade School, Pasco; St. Thomas Grade School, Coeur d'Alene; IHM High School, Coeur d'Alene, and graduated in 1968 after which he moved to Iowa to live and work with his Uncle Dean.

In July 1969 he joined the U.S. Navy and served 20 years, first as an Electronics Technician and later as an Avionics Technician. He was stationed in Lemoore CA, flying reconnaissance over Europe and the Middle East. He was stationed at Rota, Spain for eight years, during which time he enjoyed extensive travel

throughout the Mediterranean region, visiting Greece, Turkey, Italy, Germany and Cypress. He served aboard the USS Enterprise, the Commander Attack Carrier Striking Force Seventh Fleet, in the Tonkin Gulf during the Vietnam War, serving as crew chief on various aircraft. In May 1984 he received the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal for the Invasion of Grenada. David retired from the Navy in 1989.

He moved back to Spokane WA, earned an AA degree in accounting from Spokane Community College and worked for the city of Spokane for 10 years, retiring in 2000.

David loved flying and was a private and commercial pilot. He was also an avid reader.
